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UK FESTIVAL OF QUILTS TOUR

Day 1 Fly to London

Day 2

Arrive at **London** Airport and transfer to your hotel. Remainder of day free at leisure. Dinner included tonight.

🕽 Day 3

Full day textile tour, including visits to the <u>Antique Textile Company</u>, <u>Hand & Lock</u> <u>embroidery shop</u>, <u>Liberty of London</u> Store and the <u>Fashion & Textile Museum</u>,

Day 4

Self-guided visit to the <u>Victoria & Albert</u> <u>Museum</u>, followed by an afternoon visit to <u>Buckingham Palace.</u>

Day 5

Half day guided tour, including a visit to the **Tower of London**. Afternoon free at leisure.

Day 6

Travel to Hampton Court Palace for a guided tour of the **Royal School of Needlework**. Then onto Bath where a local guide will take the group on a city tour including a visit to the **Roman Baths**. Afternoon free at leisure, with dinner included.

Day 7

Transfer to Lampeter Wales to visit <u>Jen</u> Jones' Welsh Quilt Centre. Then onto Llanidloes for a visit to <u>Minerva Arts</u> <u>Centre</u>. Dinner included tonight.



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Day 8

Transfer to **Birmingham**, with the afternoon free at leisure.



Days 9 - 11

Free days to attend the Festival of Quilts. Tickets to the festival, and transfers to/from the venue are included daily.

Day 12

Travel to Haworth to visit Brontë Parsonage Museum. Continue to York, dinner included tonight

Day 13

Morning guided tour of York including. visit to York Minster. Transfer to Barnard Castle to visit Bowes Museum. Continue to York.



Day 14

Travel today to the Lake District National Park. In Bowness-on-Windermere we will take a lake cruise to take in the views, before having some free time for shopping. Transfer to Hawskhead to visit **Beatrix Potter** Gallery. Overnight in Windermere with dinner included tonight.

Day 15

Transfer to Edinburgh via Selkirk, with a visit to Lochcarron Visitors Centre included. A guided tour of the mill will be included if available on the day. Dinner included tonight in Edinburgh



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Day 16

Full day guided tour of Edinburgh, including visits to **Dovecot Tapestry** studios, the Tartan Weaving Mill Shop and Edinburgh Castle



Day 17

Morning visit to a kiltmaking demonstration, followed by an afternoon visit to Scone Palace and gardens in Perth. Return to Edinburgh

Day 18

Travel to Callander to visit Trossachs Woollen Mill, followed by free time to visit the village shops. Continue to Stirling and visit Sterling Castle. Return to Edinburgh.



Day 19

Transfer to Edinburgh airport, where the tour will end.
